

LTS - Disability Policy

London Theological Seminary considers applications from students with disabilities on the same criteria as those without disabilities. We cannot claim to have the facilities to meet every need, but will do what we reasonably can to remove any barriers to access for disabled people.

If you have a disability, we invite you to contact the Registrar and discuss your needs. It may be appropriate to arrange a visit to the Seminary to see the facilities available, and discuss the support required. No applicant will be refused admission before full consideration of the specific support required, and we will make all reasonable efforts to support disabled students. However, you should be aware that, rarely, we may have to refuse an admission on health and safety grounds, if we are unable to provide or obtain the support required.
